Mining exists safely alongside communities across these

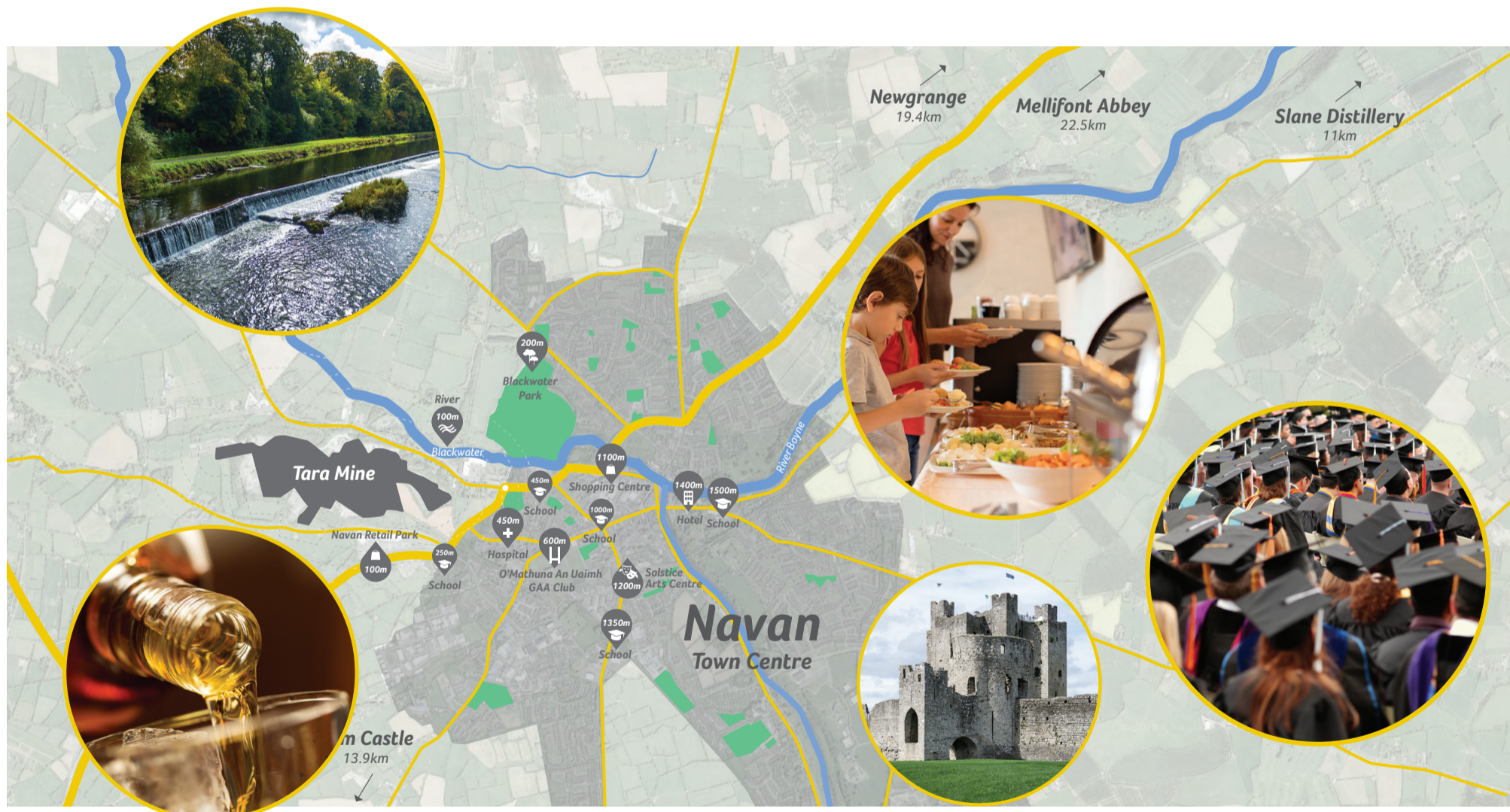
